

2010 Campsite Rental Agreement

Please read the rules and fill out the information below.

Check-in: 1500

Check-out: 1300

Camper Cabins

- ___ Camper cabin sites are allowed 2 tents; 10 people maximum.
- ___ There will be a charge of \$25 for lost keys.
- ___ Campfires are prohibited in camper cabin areas.
- ___ Portable generators are not allowed in the camper cabin areas.
- ___ Smoking, candles, lanterns, cooking equipment and any other flammable devices are prohibited in the camper cabins and front porch area.
- ___ A cleaning deposit of \$25 is required at time of check-in to be refunded upon check-out if the site is clean
- ___ Brooms are available for camper cabins thru Turtle Cove, free of charge. A \$10 replacement fee will be charged if brooms are not returned.

Campsites

- ___ Campsites are allowed 2 tents; 10 people maximum.
- ___ Campfires are prohibited in campsites.
- ___ Campsite users are NOT permitted to access or use cabin facilities.

Group Campsites

- ___ Group sites are allowed 15 tents; 75 people maximum.
- ___ Portable generators are permitted on the Paintball side of group campsites.
- ___ Only authorized personnel are allowed on the paintball field; Taking of wood from the paintball field is prohibited.
- ___ You may bring your own wood, but must remove remaining wood prior to checkout.
- ___ **Campfires are permitted only in designated fire rings, and should NOT exceed 4 ft in height.**
- ___ A cleaning deposit of \$25 is required at time of check-in to be refunded upon check-out, providing that the site is clean, picnic tables have been placed back to their designated location and all debris removed from the sink.

All Campsites

- ___ For information on sponsoring guests on to Bellows AFS, please contact the VCC (Visitor Control Center) desk between the hours of 0900-1800 at 259-4102. After hours, please contact Security Forces at 259-4200.
- ___ Quiet hours are from 2200-0800. Please be considerate of other campers and cabin occupants. Sponsor is required to be present at assigned campsite during quiet hours.
- ___ Cooking units must be located at least 6 feet from any building, tent, or combustible material, and at least 3 feet off the ground. Open unattended fires are prohibited. Grills are for outdoor cooking only. Wood is not authorized for burning in grills. Coals must be cooled and disposed of in the coal disposal areas. Do not dispose of coals on the ground or in trash receptacles.
- ___ Centralized litter containers are provided within Bellows AFS. Trash can be disposed of at any litter container nearest your campsite.
- ___ Cutting of trees is prohibited.
- ___ The use of extension cords is prohibited. No electricity is provided to any campsite on Bellows AFS.
- ___ Ants, roaches, centipedes, and termites of all shapes and sizes are commonly found in this environment. More than anything, they are a nuisance. Although we take preventative measures and work closely with entomology to conduct regular spraying, we are unable to eliminate all insects from the cabin and camping areas.
- ___ **As a result, we do not provide guest refunds for insect problems.**
- ___ No pets/animals are allowed on Bellows AFS, with the exception of ADA animals with proper documentation. In addition, the feeding of feral animals is prohibited and grounds for eviction.
- ___ **Refunds will not be given due to** beach closure, weather or natural events.

I acknowledge receipt and responsibility for the area assigned to me. Dues and fees are due upon check-in. I agree to exercise reasonable care to prevent damage or rule violations from anyone in the party. I understand that failure to obey by all rules may result in eviction from Bellows AFS with no refunds.
